A Risk Management and Facility Handover Meeting between an AWEC representative and the Hirer's nominated Risk Management Officer/Event Organiser will take place in the week prior to the Event. Please ensure your Risk Management Assessment has been completed ahead of time and provided to AWEC via office@awec.net.au

A post-event inspection of facilities and equipment will be conducted within 7 days post the event to ensure the grounds have been left in the same state as when handed over.

Your booking will not be finalised until the following has been received

- Completed and signed Booking Form
- Certificate of Currency for Public Liability Insurance
- Payment of Bonds
 - \$100 cleaning/damages bond (all hires)

- \$100 equipment damages bond (hire of portable dressage arenas and show jumps only)
- Alcohol Sales required by hirer must be run in accordance with NSW government liquor licensing regulations in conjunction with AWEC rules. The hirer must apply with NSW Office of Liquor Gaming & Racing for a Limited License Single Function. Details can be found at www.olgr.nsw.gov.au for more information phone the Office Administrator.
- Noise Levels/PA Systems No public address systems are to be operated before 8am on any
 morning. PA Systems are to be turned off by midnight on Fridays, Saturdays and any day preceding a
 public holiday, all other nights PA's must be turned off by 10pm. Music at night must be played at an
 reasonable level and must be inaudible in the residential area as soon as practical and at the latest
 by midnight. No dial is to be turned above the number 6 at any time.

AWEC Policies

- Event Cancelation Policy AWEC must be notified of the cancellation of an event in writing. If an event is cancelled within 48 hours of scheduled event time, 50% of the total fees will be charged. If an event is cancelled outside of the 48 hour period from scheduled event, 25% (the deposit) will be charged.
- The **Debt Collection Policy** applies to all hirers and can be found on our website www.awec.net.au
- **Risk Management Policy** a completed risk management form must be submitted prior to the Hand-over meeting.

Event Organiser Information

- **Bump In** (start time for bringing in equipment/setting up) is 12noon on day before. All persons, activities and undertakings on behalf of the Event Organiser are the responsibility and liability of the Hirer from that time onward. It is the Hirer's responsibility to ensure they hold sufficient and appropriate insurance cover.
- **Early Bump In** may be available by negotiation, additional costs apply.
- **Bump Out** it is expected that all equipment/belongings be removed from surfaces by the end of the day on the final event day and the facilities be returned to the state they were provided in.
- Late Bump Out may be available by negotiation, additional costs apply.

Competitor Information

- **Horses** can be tied to floats if they are under supervision during the day. Horses must not be left tied up overnight. Under no circumstances are horses to be tied to any AWEC fences.
- **Portable Yards** Due to EA regulations, there are to be no electric taped yards erected, only steel panelled yards.
- Stables, Covered Yards and Open Yards can be booked directly by competitors (unless prior arrangement is made with hirer) all bookings are done via the Online Service "Nominate" at www.nominate.com.au/stables
- Bedding for Stables and Covered Yards is to be supplied by the hirer/user. After the event all waste & bedding is to be removed and placed in the manure bays provided. If yards/stables are left dirty a \$50 per yard/stable cleaning fee will apply. AWEC management prefers that you use shavings, sawdust, rice hulls or similar (no straw) in stables/yards.
- Competitor Camping Powered and Non-powered camping is available for booking and must be booked via <u>www.nominate.com.au/stables</u>

• One vehicle per campsite - booking slips must be displayed on vehicle dash during the event.

- The **Speed Limit** on AWEC Ground is 10km
- **Dogs** must be on a lead or tied up at all times.
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted
- **Horses** in areas shared with vehicles, campsites, spectators or pedestrians must be ridden at the walk or led.
- The **Polocrosse Fields are off limits** at all times, no riding/driving/parking/camping is permitted.
